NRLN 2010 Major initiatives – Special Appeal for Funds

At this year's National Retiree Legislative Network (NRLN) Conference, the members of the NRLN Board of Directors approved the 2010 NRLN Legislative Agenda. As changes were necessary and emphasis on a particular issue was needed, the NRLN adjusted this agenda. The current agenda, as approved, can be viewed at:

The NRLN uses this document as a guideline of desired actions that we want Congress to take. There are several items from this year's Legislative Agenda that the NRLN board felt were extremely important. They are: Bankruptcy, and ERISA & PBGC Reform Legislation.

Thanks to several retiree associations who stepped up early, the NRLN has pledged for \$65,000 of its goal of \$95,000 to address these issues. But, the NRLN needs a little more for bill research, white paper development, meetings with potential bill sponsors on Capital Hill, and, if Congress fails to write a bill, the actual creation of draft bills for yet to be identified sponsoring legislators.
