AASBCR is please to advise our members of a new telephone service offering.

This offering is for retirees from what is now called:

AT&T-West (Pac Bell/Nevada Bell)

AT&T-Southwest (Southwestern Bell)

AT&T-Midwest (Ameritech/SBC)

AT&T-East (Southern New England Telephone)

And their Affiliates

And, who reside in the AT&T-Southeast (Bell South) service area.

And, have their local telephone service provided by AT&T.

AT&T has just sent out letters and applications for a new discount telephone service – concession - called “Southeast Employee At Home.” The core “Employee At Home” package includes one residential, flat-rate access line, unlimited local toll and all available vertical services. It also includes unlimited residential, direct-dialed long distance calling service throughout the U.S. for \$20 a month.

According to the AT&T letter, application forms received will be validated and processed beginning in March 2008. You may begin to see concession on your June billing statement, and possibly earlier if your application form is submitted promptly.
