Warning... AT&T 2009 healthcare enrollment is happening now!! We have become aware of members who should have already received their 2009 enrollment packages but have not yet received them. This bulletin is being issued to put you on alert.

eBenefits

eBenefits is offered by AT&T as a paperless way of staying informed about any benefits changes. As such, it is good for the environment and AT&T is not spending benefits money and sacrificing trees to inform its' retirees of benefits issues, and it is fast. AASBCRSM encourages all our members who have a computer to participate in eBenefits. Go to the AT&T access website at <http://access.att.com/>

Register if you have not already done so, login, then choose the retiree news link. On the main page, the options for retiree news including eBenefits can be selected. As an eBenefits participant, you will reduce the amount of mail delivered to your home, simplifying things for you and helping the company reduce its printing costs. If you do not sign up for eBenefits, you will continue to receive your benefits information at your home address on paper.

Please be aware that if you sign up for eBenefits, you will not receive a paper copy of the annual healthcare enrollment. An AT&T HR spokesperson stated that if you have signed up for eBenefits and have not opted out before August, you will not receive the 2009 enrollment package by mail.
