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AT&T announces the following healthcare benefit changes effective January 1, 2024:

- 1. AT&T will no longer offer an HRA to retirees or dependents.
 - Any money left in 2023 HRA will be available in 2024.
- 2. All retirees will automatically be defaulted to AT&T Group MA plan* in 2024, unless they specifically choose to opt out. Note: Retirees enrolled in Kaiser will be exempted from the automatic default
 - Yearly cost of the AT&T Group MA plan
 - In 2023 the cost will be \$0 for retiree and \$88 for dependents.
 - In 2024 the cost will be \$0 for retiree and \$50 for dependents.
 - In years 2025 -2028 the cost will be \$0 for retiree and dependents.
 - AT&T has entered into 5-year contract with United HealthCare to guarantee deductibles and other pricing.
- 3. No change in CarePlus except billing will be on an annual basis rather than monthly.
